Dr. Daniel George is the Eleanor Easley Distinguished Professor in the Duke University School of Medicine and a tenured Professor of Medicine and Surgery at Duke in the Divisions of Medical Oncology and Urology. Dr. George is an internationally recognized clinical researcher and thought leader in prostate cancer, with over 300 peer-reviewed publications in genitourinary oncology. He is the Duke Principal Investigator for the Department of Defense-sponsored prostate cancer clinical trials consortium and is a co-leader of the Prostate Cancer Foundation International prospective cohort study of men with metastatic prostate cancer. His areas of research include new drug development and biomarkers of GU cancers.
